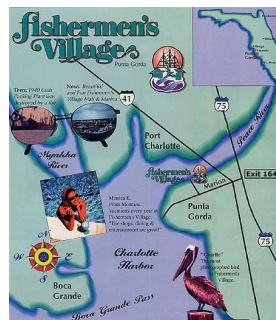


Military Heritage Museum & Fisherman's Village
