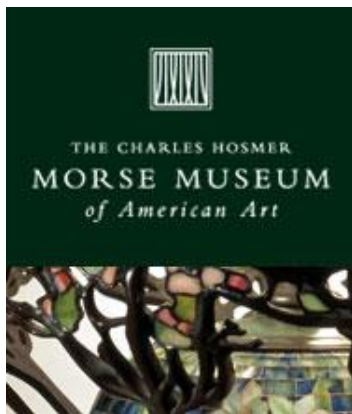


# Morse Museum & Boat Tour of Winter Park October 16th, 2019
