14 Night Panama Canal Partial Transit

November 4 - 18, 2018

Join us as we embark on an unparalleled journey to the Panama Canal for a partial transit to Gatun Lake and many other exotic Caribbean ports. Explore the ship as we set sail to **Georgetown, Grand Caymen** Georgetown is the capital of the Cayman Islands and one of the most popular cruise ship destinations in the Caribbean, don't miss Stingray City, diving and snorkeling. Georgetown offers plenty of duty-free shopping, restaurants and cafes. Next stop **Falmouth, Jamaica** It's a busy cruise-ship port that lies between Ocho Rios and Montego Bay on the island's north shore. The city is characterized by its Georgian architecture, concentrated in the Falmouth Historic District. East, near Ocho Rios, Dunn's River Falls cascades over limestone rocks. We then arrive to **Santa Marta, Columbia** a city on the Caribbean Sea in the northern Colombian department of Magdalena. A busy port, it was also the first Spanish settlement in Colombia. It's the gateway for trips into the Tayrona National Natural Park, and for multi day guided treks to the Lost City (Teyuna). We then will arrive to **Cartagena, Columbia** it is a port city on Colombia's Caribbean coast. By the sea is the walled Old Town, founded in the 16th century, with squares, cobblestone streets and colorful colonial buildings. With a tropical climate, the city is also a popular beach destination. We now enter the highlight of the cruise we will do a partial transit of the **Panama Canal to Gatun Lake**, The Panama Canal is an artificial 48-mile waterway in Panama that connects the Atlantic Ocean with the Pacific Ocean. The canal cuts across the Isthmus of Panama and is a key conduit for international maritime trade. we will do a turn around in the lake and head back out to sea . Next we will make a port in **Colon Panama**, Colón is the capital of Colón Province, in Panama. It sits on the Caribbean coast, at the entrance to the Panama Canal. The Canal Expansion Observation Center is a park with viewing platforms over the canal's Atlantic locks and Gatún Lake. Now we whisk you off to **Puerto Limon, Costa Rica**, a port town on Costa Rica's Caribbean coast, has a somewhat limited tourist infrastructure but as a regular port of call for several major cruise lines, it serves as a convenient hub for reaching nearby attractions and natural wonders throughout the country. After a day at sea to relax we will arrive in **Santo Tomas de Castilla, Guatemala** Located on the eastern coast of Honduras, Santa Tomas de Castilla was originally settled in the 19th century by Belgian pioneers. Check out the abundant flora and fauna of Las Escobas Waterfalls, located within the protected nature reserve at the Cerro San Gil. We then pit stop at **Harvest Caye**, NCL's private beach resort to have a fun sun day. Our final stop on this adventure will be **Costa Maya, Mexico** one of Mexico's most popular cruise ports. The modern port is able to accommodate three ships at once, and entertain visitors at a destination that showcases the ancient and colonial heritage of the Mexican Caribbean. Costa Maya is comprised of three grand pavilions, artisan and luxury shopping areas, a beach club, saltwater pools, fine restaurants and bars, and all the resources necessary to explore the surrounding jungle. Here on this trip are all the ingredients needed for a complete escape for today's world, won't you join us for an adventure of a lifetime!
