

Cracker Creek & Aunt Catfish February 8th, 2024

Join us for a one of a kind tour! James N. Gamble, of the Procter and Gamble Company and a long time winter resident of Daytona Beach, bought land on Spruce Creek for use as a rural retreat. Gamble Place is adjacent to Cracker Creek, and is surrounded by an associated 175-acre nature preserve. Guests to Gamble Place can step back in time to experience the same pristine environment that James N. Gamble found so inviting during his first visit to the area in the late 1800's. Included in the National Register of Historic Places, Gamble Place features a historic home, cottage, and Citrus Packing House. The "Florida Cracker Style" house named "Egwanulti" (a Native American word meaning "by the water"), was built in 1907, and used as a winter retreat. The once privately-owned Citrus Packing House is the only one currently in existence in its original location in Florida. After a tour of Gamble Place, we will embark on a one hour Eco boat tour of Cracker Creek. Then we will depart for a delicious lunch at Aunt Catfish, an eclectic waterfront restaurant. Finally, we will make a stop at Angell & Phelps chocolate factory for a tasting. You won't want to miss this wonderful day out! Activity Level 2
