Join us as we embark on an unparalleled journey to the Panama Canal for a partial transit to Gatun Lake and many other exotic Caribbean ports. Explore the ship as we set sail to our first port, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands. Georgetown is the capital of the Cayman Islands and one of the most popular cruise ship destinations in the Caribbean, don't miss Stingray City, diving and snorkeling. Georgetown offers plenty of duty-free shopping, restaurants and cafes. Next stop Falmouth, Jamaica It's a busy cruise-ship port that lies between Ocho Rios and Montego Bay on the island's north shore. The city is characterized by its Georgian architecture, concentrated in the Falmouth Historic District. East, near Ocho Rios, Dunn's River Falls cascades over limestone rocks. We then will arrive at *Puerto Limon, Costa Rica*, a port town on Costa Rica's Caribbean coast, has a somewhat limited tourist infrastructure but as a regular port of call for several major cruise lines, it serves as a convenient hub for reaching nearby attractions and natural wonders throughout the country. With a tropical climate, the city is also a popular beach destination. We now enter the highlight of the cruise we will do a partial transit of the *Panama Canal* to *Ga*tun Lake, The Panama Canal is an artificial 48-mile waterway in Panama that connects the Atlantic Ocean with the Pacific Ocean. The canal cuts across the Isthmus of Panama and is a key conduit for international maritime trade, we will do a turn around in the lake and head back out to sea. Next we will make a port in **Colon Panama**, Colón is the capital of Colón Province, in Panama. It sits on the Caribbean coast, at the entrance to the Panama Canal. The Canal Expansion Observation Center is a park with viewing platforms over the canal's Atlantic locks and Gatún Lake. Now after a day at sea, we whisk you off to Incredible Aruba, an island country in the Caribbean Sea that is part of the Kingdom of the Netherlands. It's known for its white sand beaches, clear blue water, and year-round sunshine. Next, we will stop at Curacao, the "C" in the ABC islands, Curação features historic settlements, rugged landscapes and plenty of fun in the sun. After our adventures, we will have 2 days at sea before returning to Ft. Lauderdale!
