


Wild Wild West

Grapevine, Tx - Waco - Magnolia Market & Silos - San Antonio - New Orleans & More



On Day One, we will meet new friends as we travel west to the Gulfport, MS area. We will enjoy dinner with our friends before retiring for the evening at our hotel. **D**

Our Second Day we will enjoy a nice breakfast at our hotel before continuing west to Texas. We have a fun stop along the way at **Landry Vineyards** for a short tour with tasting of several of their distinctive wines. Continuing into the great state of Texas, we will arrive at our hotel in the afternoon. The new **Hotel Vin** is located in the historic district of **Grapevine, Tx**. You will have time to freshen' up before dinner. **B,D**

We will start our **3rd Day** with breakfast and then a tour of Historic Grapevine with time for shopping in the unique shops, boutiques and winery tasting rooms in the preserved historic area. At noon we will all gather at the **Glockenspiel Clock Tower** to see two 9-ft tall Glockenspiel characters - The Train Robbers emerge from the tower which reflects the Western lore that people love about Texas. In the afternoon, we will travel the **Urban Wine Trail** with stops at a couple wineries. Texas is now the 5th largest wine producing state and is growing in nostalgia and notoriety with Grapevine as its leader. This evening we will enjoy a side-splitting Murder Mystery Dinner Show - 1880 Texas style! - at the **Texas Star Dinner Theater**. **B,D**

Day four - Breakfast and more! The morning brings us to the Historic Nash Farm which is complete with crafts, exhibits, interpretive programs and displays which brings this historic landmark to life. Next, step on your boots as we board the **Grapevine Vintage Railroad**. Step back in time as we experience train travel as it was in the glory days. We will pull directly into the Stockyards national Historic District where the West comes alive. Here, you will have time to explore the unique shops and visit the **Texas Hall of Fame**, the **Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame** and see the famous **Cattle Drive** that travels through the **Historic Fort Worth Stockyards**. Big day...the night will be as well as we dine to the sounds of live music and dancing at the "**The Worlds Largest Honky Tonk**" **Billy Bob's** is a truly exciting entertainment facility. **B,D**

Day Five - After breakfast, we will travel to **Waco** to visit **Chip and Joanne**. Take time to tour and explore **HGTV's Fixer Upper's Magnolia Market & Silos**. Visit the Silo Baking Co, paly games on the lawn, or take a ride on the Silo Downtown Trolley. Visit all the cool shops, watering holes, restaurants and mny other fun places that make Waco great. We will check-in at our local Waco hotel before heading to dinner at **Vitek's BBQ** which was made famous with its appearance on Fixer Upper several times - maybe we will see Chip & Joanne there! **B,D**

Rise and shine! **Day Six**. Breakfast before we depart Waco for our trip south for a 2-night stay in beautiful San Antonio. Remember the Alamo! Upon arrival, our first stop will be **Market Square** which is the largest Mexican Market in the U.S. Enjoy lunch and time for shopping while taking in the culture of the Mexican way of life which is just as much a part of Texas as is the Texan lifestyle. This afternoon, we will check into our **Riverwalk Hotel**. This evening you will experience one of the most famous attractions in the U.S. Witness the sights, sounds, and smells of a dinner and narrated cruise on the San Antonio River, or **Paseo del Rio**, world-renowned 15-mile urban waterway. This truly experience of a lifetime is a treasure and the largest urban ecosystem in the nation. Tucked quietly below street level and only steps from the Alamo, it provides a serene and pleasant way to navigate the city while in the heart of downtown. After dinner, return to our hotel, or take a stroll along the **Riverwalk** to visit the shops or perhaps enjoy drinks at an outside café while listening to music and watching the barges cruise by. **B,D**

Day Seven. Arise early with the sun or sleep in. Today is yours. Breakfast - at your hotel at your leisure as is the rest of the day. Today is yours to explore. Visit Spanish Missions, Institute of Texas Culture, Texas Ranger Museum, Museum of Art, Tower of Americas, Bulkhorn Saloon and more. You will have the freedom to see and stay as long as you wish at any attraction or ride the entire tour loop and end the tour at your leisure. While the day was yours to explore and shop, the evening is yours as well. There are countless restaurants and cafes for you to choose from tonight. Dine on the gorgeous Riverwalk or take in the panoramic view at the Tower of Americas' revolving restaurant which sits 750-ft high with views to remember forever. **B**

Day Eight. Enjoy breakfast before we begin our trip back East. Start practicing your cajun accent as we arrive into **New Orleans**. We will check into our downtown hotel which is steps away from all the fun. Ride the trolley through the **Garden District** - try your luck at the casino - stroll the Riverwalk - Coffee & Beignets in Jackson Square - dinner and drinks on your own in the French Quarter on **Bourbon Street** - the evening is yours to enjoy and explore on your own. We will provide you with a 24hr trolley pass that will deliver you to all the fun. **B**
